ICON HD ANATOMY





IF THE LED RING IS ...

- FLASHING RED+WHITE
 ICON HD is in pairing mode.
- FLASHING WHITE
 ICON HD is trying to connect
 to your phone.
- FLASHING RED

 Battery is low. Power up!

POWER UP

To charge, plug your headset into the wall charger or USB port on your computer.



NOTE It takes 40 minutes to get your ICON HD 80% charged. A full charge takes 90 minutes. When fully charged, the LED RING on your ICON HD will turn white.

TO HEAR REMAINING BATTERY LIFE

Press the **TALK BUTTON** when not on a call.

WHEN BATTERY IS LOW

The **LED RING** on your ICON HD will flash **RED**.

BATTERY METER ON YOUR PHONE

PHONE®

Shows up automatically when connected.

ENSURE BEST QUALITY

VOICE ACTIVITY SENSOR



For best performance, the rubber Voice Activity Sensor should touch your cheek and the headset should point towards your mouth.

2 GET CONNECTED

Before you can begin using your ICON HD*, you must pair it with your phone or Bluetooth device.



- 1 Press & hold the TALK BUTTON.
- 2 Slide the **POWER SWITCH** on.
- 3 Wait for the LED RING to flash red & white.
- 4 Release the TALK BUTTON.

PAIR ICON HD WITH YOUR PHONE

- 1 Activate pairing mode on your ICON HD.
- 2 Turn on Bluetooth*.

ON AN IPHONE®

Go to **SETTINGS > GENERAL >** and enable **BLUETOOTH**.

ON A BLACKBERRY*

Go to **SETTINGS/OPTIONS** > **BLUETOOTH** and enable **BLUETOOTH**.

ON AN ANDROID" PHONE

Go to SETTINGS > WIRELESS
& NETWORK > BLUETOOTH SETTINGS
and enable BLUETOOTH.

OTHER CELL PHONES

Go to **JAWBONE.COM/PAIRING** or review the instruction manual that came with your phone.

3 Go to your phone's Bluetooth® settings.

ADD OR SEARCH FOR DEVICES

When "Jawbone ICON HD" appears, select it.

IF ASKED FOR A PASSCODE Enter "0000".

This is a one-time event per phone. To pair your ICON HD to another phone, repeat these steps.

GET TALKING & MORE

ANSWER/END A CALL

Press the **TALK BUTTON** on your ICON HD to both answer and end a call.

DECLINE AN INCOMING CALL

Hold the **TALK BUTTON** for 2 seconds.

MAKE A CALL

Use your phone or computer to dial as usual. Listen and talk through your ICON HD.

ACTIVATE DIALAPP (PHONE ONLY)
Hold the TALK BUTTON until you hear
a beep, then release and follow the voice
prompts. VoiceDial is pre-loaded.

REDIAL LAST NUMBER (PHONE ONLY)

Press the TALK BUTTON twice.

SIMULTANEOUS CALLS

To switch between calls, press the **TALK BUTTON.** To end one call and switch to the other, press the **TALK BUTTON** twice.

ADJUST THE VOLUME

Use the volume control on your phone or computer. Or, while on a call or listening to music, PRESS + HOLD the TALK BUTTON. The volume level will cycle up and down. Release the button to set your volume.

CONTROL MEDIA

To pause streaming audio playing from your mobile device, press the **TALK BUTTON** once. To play, press three times.
